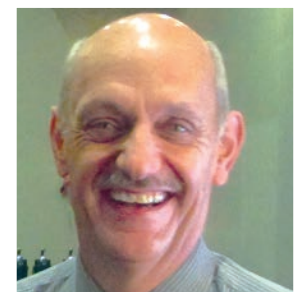



Along with Kayla Yewchuk, Radiology Technologist, co-chairs of the Annual Charity Open Golf Tournament, Dave Barnard and Dr. Bob Burechailo check out the new upgrade from analogue to digital for the X-Ray Trauma Room. This upgrade was funded through the proceeds from the Annual Golf Tournament and enables faster throughput for patients and improved ergonomics for the staff. Images are produced much faster and at a higher quality. Because X-ray images are seen within 3 seconds of an exposure, technologists are able to instantly determine if further imaging is required and complete exams with fewer delays. Faster diagnosis improves patient care.

Foundation to the rescue with the purchase of a new Gamma Probe

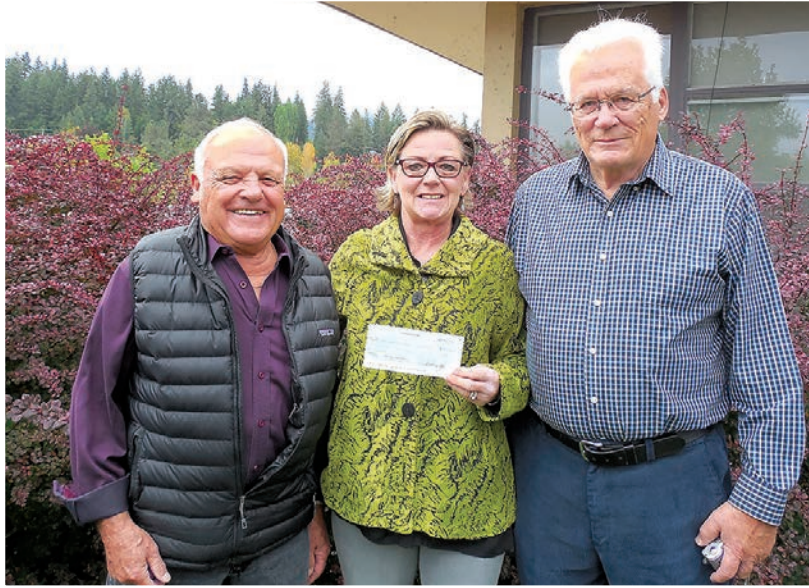
"Not too long ago, our gamma probe, which is a very important tool in our surgical armamentarium, broke down. This tool is used to detect lymph nodes primarily in breast cancer patients and also in patients with melanomas," wrote Dr. Johannes Schneider, F.R.C.S. (C) in a recent letter of thanks sent to the Shuswap Hospital Foundation. The gamma probe was purchased immediately in order to ensure that there were no delays or surgery postponements.

Caring and sharing

The Shuswap Lake Healthcare Auxiliary is comprised of passionate, caring, and dedicated volunteers and through their hard work and active fundraising, they have been able to provide some much needed equipment to the Shuswap Lake Hospital. Through a generous private donation, a purchase of temporal thermometers for the ICU was made possible. Community Care

The staff at Hospital and Communities Integrated Services for Interior Health support our community by providing health services in many ways that support our commitment to the "home is best" philosophy of client care.

Service provided by the home health team may include:

- Home nursing care management
- Occupational and Physiotherapy Services
- Respiratory Therapy
- Palliative Care
- Home Support Service which includes personal care delivered in the client home.
- Community Bath program

Respite care services provided to decrease care giver strain are offered through in-home support service, Adult Day Program service and

access to community respite beds, which may include a combination of services determined through a client specific assessment.

Community Care clinic which operates 7 days per week and provides over 4,000 visits annually. Visits include services such as wound care therapy antibiotic administration and catheter maintenance.

Senior's Health and Wellness Centre – comprehensive client assessment services for frail or medically complex senior through a multidisciplinary approach. The care team at the centre includes a registered nurse, physician, registered dietitian, social worker, occupational therapist, physiotherapist, recreation therapist, pharmacist and other health-care practitioners as needed.

Coming in January 2019 - Home Health Surveillance Nursing Program.

Making a Difference for our Seniors

There are a number of facilities within our Shuswap area that offer different levels of care for our seniors, depending on their needs. Bastion Place is a 80 bed complex residential care facility which is owned and operated by Interior Health. 67 permanent

and 13 short stay beds provide convalescent, respite and end-of-life care for residents. In addition there are many recreational opportunities, with activities, games and outings for residents. Harmony Haven provides an adult services program, it is part of Shuswap

Home Health Services and provides seniors with activities and events.

In addition there are facilities such as Piccadilly Care Centre, Pioneer Lodge and Mount Ida Mews which has recently been expanded.

The lab collection service was opened in Sicamous in March 2013. The Shuswap Hospital Foundation funded \$10,000 for equipment and the lab is still a busy place today. Local patients requiring weekly or frequent testing are able to use the Sicamous lab rather than traveling out of town.



Bastion Place was recently provided with a bladder scanner through the Shuswap Hospital Foundation. The addition of this equipment has enabled staff the ability to extend the level of care for residents at Bastion Place.

Sorrento & Area Community Health Centre

The Sorrento & Area Community Health Centre has now been in operation for five years and is excited to announce the appointment of a new Nurse Practitioner, Theresa Smith, effective July 1, 2018, following the retirement of Judy Deringer who opened the clinic for us in November, 2013. The Shuswap Hospital Foundation was among the first of the community organizations to help realize a dream by funding much of the medical equipment needed at the time of opening in November, 2013.

Theresa and her partner moved into the area recently and love the outdoor opportunities the Shuswap offers.



Theresa is taking new patients and is currently seeking hospital privileges at Shuswap Lake General Hospital.

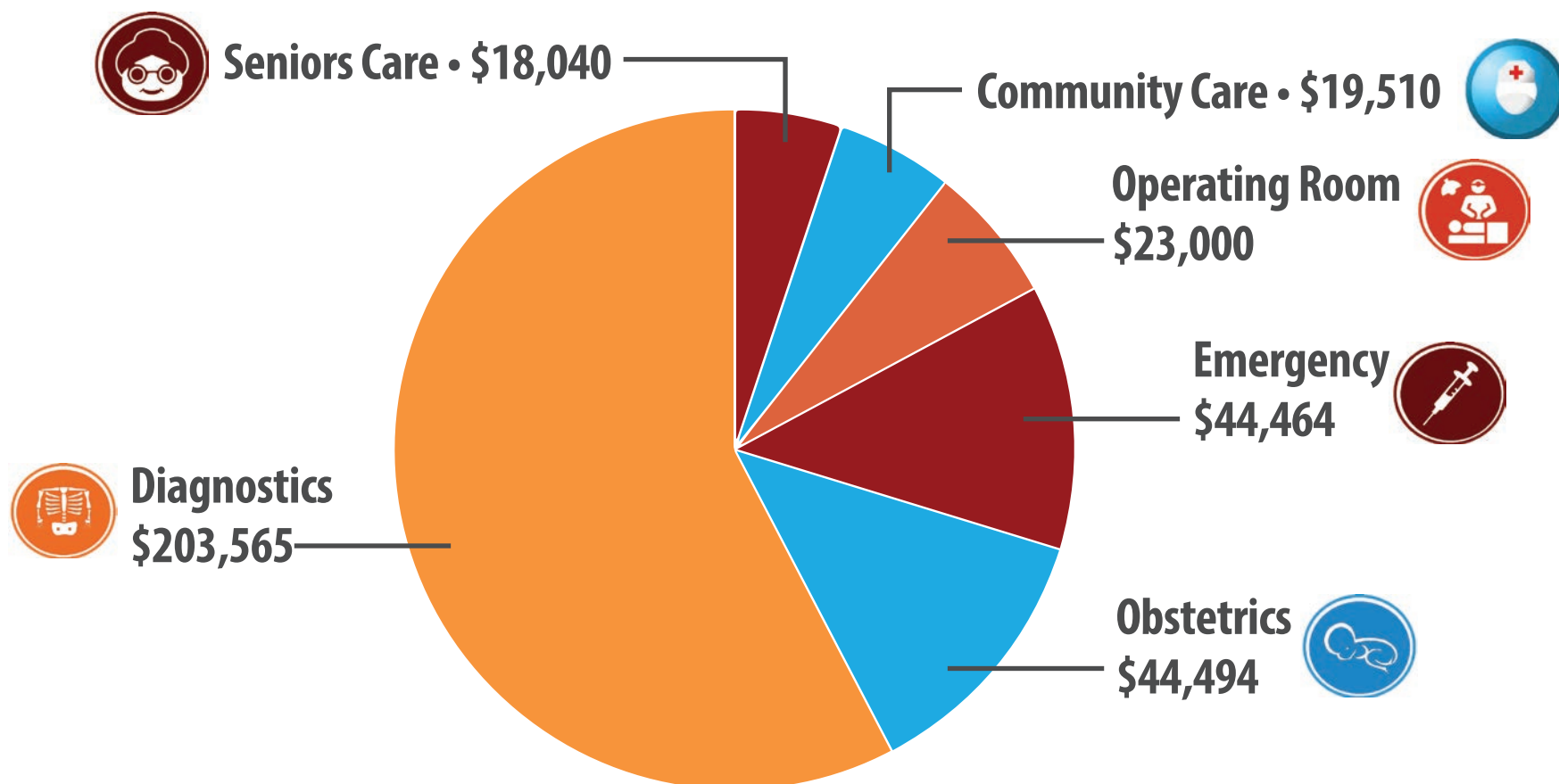

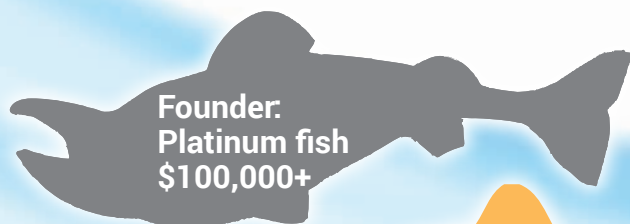


Recognition Wall
